- (1.) I PROMISE TO HAVE FUN!
- (2.) I agree to be respectful and obey all posted rules, warnings and further agree to follow any oral instructions or directions given by *PLAY WITH CLAY* employees, volunteers, and representatives.
- (3.) I recognize that there are inherent risks associated with my participation, and I assume full responsibility for personal injury, loss or damage arising out of my family's use of or presence upon the facilities of *PLAY WITH CLAY*, whether caused by the fault of myself, my family, *PLAY WITH CLAY* staff or third party.
- (4.) I agree to pay for all damages to the facilities of *PLAY WITH CLAY* caused by my or my families negligent, reckless, or willful actions and to defend *PLAY WITH CLAY* against all claims.
- (5.) I acknowledge that *PLAY WITH CLAY* cannot be held responsible for accidents resulting from misuse of equipment, medical problems resulting from contact with skin, or ingestion and/or inhalation of toxic materials, and am healthy enough to engage in this activity under these conditions.
- (6.) If I choose to fire items, I will take detailed photographs and retain pictures of my creations at the end of each class as they are imperative to claim my pieces. Pottery cannot be taken home without these pictures.
- (7.) In the instance of breakage or firing mishap/loss, I understand the "No Refund Policy" and accept only equal credit within the studio. I understand if these uncontrollable factors occur, I will choose to only receive credit or choose a staff made replacement.
- (8.) I am aware if I do not return within <u>4 months to collect my ceramic work</u> from its creation or glaze date, it becomes property of *PLAY WITH CLAY*, and will be disposed of. I understand I am not entitled to any reimbursement and all credit protocol would be forfeited.
